BRAZORIA COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 26


The Board of Directors of Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 26 will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, May 5, 2015, at 11:00 a.m., at the office of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2600, in the Colorado Conference Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following:

 - b. construction of District facilities, including approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate for:
 - i. public lines to serve Shadow Creek Ranch MF 5;
 - ii. public water line to serve Broadstone Shadow Creek; and
 - iii. detention pond erosion protection.
 - c. deeds and easements; and
 - d. surplus funds application and bond application no. 8.
