


NOTICE OF MEETING

BRAZORIA COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 26

The Board of Directors of Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 26 will hold a regular meeting on Tuesday, June 2, 2015, at 11:00 a.m., at the office of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2600, in the Colorado Conference Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following:

1. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
2. Security Services Report.
3. Development in the District and approval of any financing agreements, execution of waivers of special appraisal; and approve any developer reimbursement reports and disbursements of funds.
4. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, investment of District funds, and amend budget.
5. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installation agreements, payment of tax bills, and authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
6. Recreational facilities in and near the District, including:
 - a. City of Pearland's schedule for design and construction of regional sports park;
 - b. construction of temporary ball fields, including approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance;
 - c. proposal for mowing of temporary ball fields;
 - d. approve signage for temporary ball fields; and
 - e. Cost-Sharing Agreement with Brazoria-Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 1 for maintenance of temporary ball fields.

 - a. design of District facilities, approval of plans and specifications, authorization to advertise for bids, award of construction contracts, and execution of any related letter financing agreements;
 - b. construction of District facilities, including approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate for:
 - i. public lines to serve Shadow Creek Ranch MF 5;
 - ii. public water line to serve Broadstone Shadow Creek; and
 - iii. detention pond erosion protection.
 - c. deeds and easements; and
 - d. bond application no. 8.
