

## NOTICE OF MEETING

### BRAZORIA-FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1


The Board of Directors of Brazoria-Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on Friday, April 6, 2018, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Sabine Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Director matters, including:
  - a. accept resignation of Director Ruiz and appoint new director;
  - b. approve Sworn Statement, Official Bond, and Oath of Office of new director;
  - c. reorganize the Board and authorize execution of District Registration Form;
  - d. Open Meetings Act and Public Information Act Training Requirements; and
  - e. conflict of interest disclosure required under Chapter 176 of the Texas Local Government Code, including review of disclosure forms adopted by the Texas Ethics Commission and List of Local Government Officers.
2. Minutes of prior meeting(s).
3. Comments from the public.
4. Security Services Report and approval of security patrol services agreement.
5. Newsletter and website matters, including approve proposal for email/text alerts and separate Brazoria-Fort Bend County MUD No. 1 website and authorize termination of letter agreement with Brazoria County MUD No. 26 for cost sharing of joint website.
6. Development in the District and approval of any financing agreements, execution of waivers of special appraisal, and approve any developer reimbursement reports and disbursement of funds.
7. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
8. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. design of District facilities, approval of plans and specifications, authorization to advertise for bids, award of construction contracts, and execution of any related letter financing agreements;
  - b. construction of water, sewer, and drainage facilities, including approve pay estimates, change orders and final acceptance;
  - c. deeds and easements and related phase I environmental assessment proposals;
  - d. impact fee payments;
  - e. storm water permitting matters for Permit TXRQ40000;
  - f. update on City of Pearland's expansion of sewage treatment plant;
  - g. report on inspection of District's storm sewers; and
  - h. update on bond application no. 9.
9. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, review of investments, and budget comparison.
10. Reports from Directors, District consultants and SCRMA regarding events and activities attended during the month.
11. Attorney's report, including:
  - a. Blue Ridge Landfill odor matters and efforts to ensure compliance of the Landfill's TCEQ permit; and
  - b. approve District Information Kit.
12. Date, time, and location for next District meeting.

14. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding matters related to Blue Ridge Landfill, including Texas Commission on Environmental Quality monitoring regarding permit violations.
15. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.076, Texas Government Code, to deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices, or a security audit.
16. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding deployment, or specific occasions for implementation of security personnel or devices.
